Hoping I can make it to the reunion. It's crazy how few names of fellow '71 Generals I remember. I'm looking forward to renewing acquaintances.

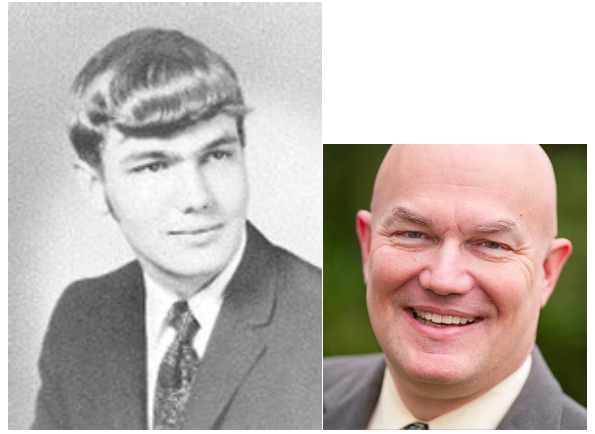

Gerry O'Shaughnessy taught my algebra II/pre-calc class in 10th grade. Gerry had a strong sense of humor and it enlivened that class considerably, during a year when some of my other teachers did not seem especially happy in class.

My dad was among other things a bit of an electronics hobbyist back then. He had built a very simple gadget, a blinking light. He was hooked!

He treasured that box, and showed it off. Alas, somebody else also found it irresistible, and it was stolen.

After 40 years, it probably blinks about once a day. So yes, Big Brother is still watching.

Tourism update for reunion weekend

A couple of local landmarks are not open, alas, due to earthquake damage.

The initial engineering survey of damage to the Washington Monument is finished, but repairs have not begun and the Monument is closed. Locally we have been entertained for days by news photos of and interviews with the engineers hanging on ropes from the top of the Monument, literally inspecting each stone block on the outside. They also used the interior stairs to inspect every block on the inside. The ABC TV affiliate had a TV crew on assignment watching the engineers constantly, maybe anticipating an unanticipated adverse event.

The National Cathedral is also closed. It has been under construction almost continuously for all of our lives, and had a tall construction crane onsite as of the earthquake. The crane collapsed, and fell on two outbuildings.

Engineers have been all over the exterior of that massive building also to identify quake damage.

If you want an alternative elevated view of the city, I suggest the Old Post Office Tower at the corner of 12th and Pennsylvania Northwest. When we were at WL, this was a working US Post Office and a beautiful example of late 19th century grandeur (looks like it belongs in Toronto). Now, you can ride the elevator to the top for free, and the view to the Capital and across the Potomac is terrific. Also this is the new home of the Bells of Congress, and you can see those just below the top level of the tower. To enter the building, you will have to go through security and have your bags xrayed. The building has food and souvenir vendors on the plaza level. The closest on-street parking is on 12th Street or on Constitution or Pennsylvania close to 12th Street. Closest Metro station is Federal Triangle.

The newest Washington museums charge admission.

The Newseum on Pennsylvania Ave was located in Rosslyn until 2004, and is a fascinating place for both new and old news. You can see the latest news photos, the latest front pages from around the world, and copies of London newspapers reporting the Great Fire in the 1660s. Closest Metro station is Archives/Navy Memorial. Current exhibits include photos by the US President's Photographers, and Pictures of the Year. www.newseum.org

The National Geographic Museum never fails to fascinate. 17th and M Streets NW. Closest Metro station is Farragut North. <http://events.nationalgeographic.com/events/locations/center/museum>

The Spy Museum at 800 F Street, NW sheds light on the international history of spying, and concentrates on recent notorious spies including Aldrich Ames at the CIA and Robert Hanssen at the FBI. The video interviews with Ames' co-workers are especially interesting. Closest Metro station is Chinatown/Gallery Place. Local note: Ames lived across Randolph Street from Daisy Hash Krout's cousin in Dover, in a home previously owned by an Apollo astronaut. www.spymuseum.org

Wrap up of Arlington Now

Evidently I hit a ceiling that I did not know of. The final couple of paragraphs about Arlington Now got truncated. Here they are

Stratford eventually became the home of both the Woodlawn alternative high school and the Hoffman-Boston alternative middle school. The combo is now known as the H-B Woodlawn Secondary Program, including grades 6-12 and containing about 600 students (versus 900 per year when we attended Junior High). School starts at 9:20 AM and ends at 4:05 PM for all grades at H-B Woodlawn, a very reasonable set of hours for teenagers, though some electives are offered at 8:30 AM for high school students there. The Stratford building has been expanded. The first floor hall once featured classrooms on the football field side and a blank wall on the opposite side; now there are classrooms on both sides. A music wing was built adjacent the auditorium in the past ten years. It is very sophisticated, with ceiling mics and recording gear in the practice rooms. The industrial arts space under the auditorium is now devoted to classrooms for art, photography and computer multimedia.

Alas, the H-B Woodlawn auditorium still has the same painful wooden seats that we and our parents tolerated in the 1960s. No wonder my parents always showed up late for concerts and stage plays.

The music and drama programs at W-L, H-B Woodlawn and Yorktown are terrific. If you are in the area, catch one of their concerts; admission is free and you won't be disappointed. All three schools stage at least one major dramatic production, usually a musical comedy, during the year.

The school web sites include the calendar of concerts and plays (they charge for admission to most plays). Also the marching band programs at W-L and Yorktown are superb, both definitely college quality.

Arlington Now

Probably the biggest change in Arlington is the presence of the Metrorail subway system. With a line along the river from Rosslyn to the National Airport and points beyond, and another from Rosslyn along Wilson Blvd, Fairfax Drive and I-66, much of the commercial growth in the region has clustered around Metro stations. You will see that many neighborhood home blocks along those lines close to stations have become commercial zones.

Impacted by Metro are these Arlington stations:

Crystal City - Growing considerably due to easy access to the airport and to DC. The US Patent Office moved to Alexandria but other large tenants have relentlessly moved in.

Rosslyn - taller high rises and more of them, still Baby Manhattan.

Courthouse - new courts building, county government building, and jail, along with many high rises

Clarendon - Clarendon Trust and the entire south side of Wilson completely redeveloped. On the north side, a high rise sits atop the old parking lot behind the shops. Clarendon Baptist is building a mixed use apartment building and church.

Virginia Square - the former locale of Kanns department store is now the law school of George Mason University.

Ballston - taller high rises and more of them, and both Bob Peck Chevrolet and the Putt-Putt minigolf are gone.

Parkington has been renovated into a multi-storey mall called Ballston Commons, with the Washington Capitals

practice rink on top of the parking lot, open to the public for skating.

Under construction now is an extension of the Metro westward Orange line through Tysons Corner to Dulles Airport. You can see some of the construction in the median of the Dulles Access Road.

Also under development now is a streetcar system along Columbia Pike covering both Arlington and part of Fairfax.

I-66 itself cut deeply into the county parks along Four Mile Run in North Arlington. You will find a large and beautiful public rose garden at the edge of Bon Air Park along Wilson Blvd. near our Sunday picnic pavilion. A bit west on Wilson, up the hill, is the county's skate park, for skateboard daredevils.

Home prices skyrocketed during the real estate boom of the early 2000s. Most homes in Arlington tripled in assessed value between 1999 and 2005, and property taxes tripled too. You can type in your old address and see the most recent assessment at:

The county has taken advantage of the internet era in other ways. Utility bills, taxes, and even traffic tickets can be paid online.

All Arlington schools are extensively wired for internet, including all classrooms. Teachers are now trained and tested for proficiency in email and Web use. The school library system, now unified with the county library system, even has a Web page enabling any card holder to see what they have checked out and when each item is due. Items checked out can be renewed online.

Whether it is high gas prices or recessions, any economic shock encourages people with long commutes to move closer to their jobs, either to save time or money, so Arlington homes are still in demand compared even to areas such as Manassas or western Fairfax.

Another notable trend is home conversions. Builders or homeowners redevelop or expand their homes, often reducing or eliminating yard space. This has happened to the house I grew up in. The era of lawn and garden hobbies may be drawing to an end as two-career families become more numerous and busier.

Washington-Lee is not the only school to have a makeover. In the last 10 years, Arlington has been busy. After construction of WL3 was completed, Yorktown began several years of expansion. The oldest part of that building, originally an elementary school, is being torn down now. Wakefield broke ground on its renovation effort this year.

Several elementary schools were surplused in the late 1970s when incoming population shrank.

- * Woodlawn on North 16th Street, possibly the second oldest school building then in use, became an alternative high school, and then a hospice
- * Madison at the corner of Military and Old Glebe became a rec center -- yes there is a newer Glebe Road, north of Walker Chapel
 - * Woodmont on North Fillmore became a rec center
 - * Lee at the corner of Lee Highway and Lexington became a rec center
 - * Page was closed
 - * Claremont, in south Arlington, became a police training school
 - * Maury, the oldest in operation in the 1950s, became a visual arts center

The Woodlawn alternative high school was created during our senior year, when my dad was chairman of the

School Board. The final issue of Crossed Sabres in our senior year included a front page story written by Jim Guinivan reporting that the School Board had approved the proposal.

Later the local population trend reversed, and enrollments grew. Arlington expanded many elementary schools, including Taylor, Nottingham, Page (now Science Focus) and Tuckahoe. Clarmont is once again an elementary school. A new elementary school, Carlin Springs, was built on the edge of the Kenmore Middle School property. Hoffman-Boston has also been converted to an elementary school.

Currently, school years are distributed among Arlington schools this way: K-5 in elementary school, 6-8 in middle school, 9-12 in high school. The high school change was first, due to declining enrollments, and then the junior highs contained only grades 7-8 and were called intermediate schools. During that time both Stratford and Gunston were closed. Later Gunston was reopened.

Many middle schools have been completely rebuilt or extensively renovated. The new Kenmore is less than 10 years old, the new TJ is approaching 30 and has the largest gym in the county. Williamsburg has additional classrooms connecting two wings, Swanson was extensively renovated, and Gunston was extensively renovated. Both Gunston and TJ are now jointly Recreation centers and schools, and both host very lively theater productions by local groups throughout the year. TJ is also home to the Arlington County Fair each August. See www.arlingtoncountyfair.us.

Stratford eventually became the home of both the Woodlawn alternative high school and the Hoffman-Boston alternative middle school. The combo is now known as the H-B Woodlawn Secondary Program, including grades 6-12 and containing about 600 students (versus 900 per year when we attended Junior High). School starts at 9:20 AM and ends at 4:05 PM for all grades at H-B Woodlawn, a very reasonable set of hours for teenagers, though some electives are offered at 8:30 AM for high school students there. 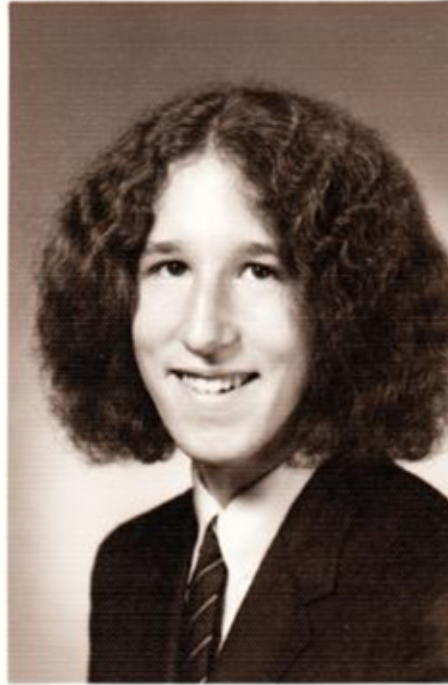

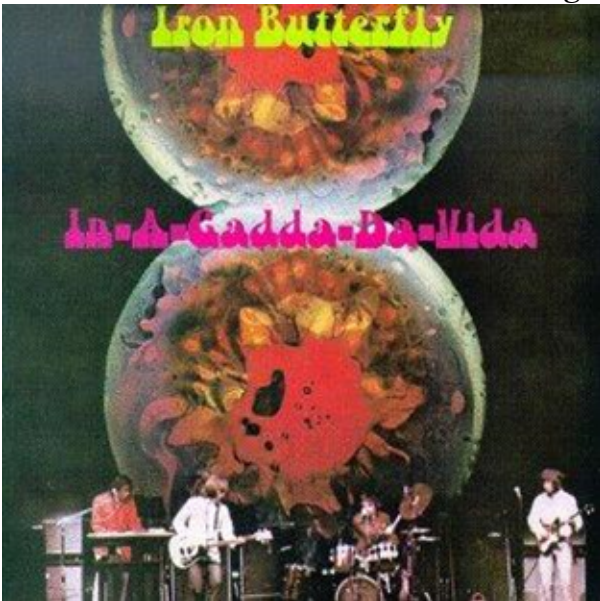
